



## WORK REGULATIONS for AWARDS 2023 face-to-face and online (until September 30 /2023

The works that are presented will be assigned by the author to one or two of the 32 thematic areas. A prize will be awarded for the best free communication, and another prize for the best clinical case in each thematic area <a href="Free communications FC">Free communications FC</a> are those that have a relevant methodological design and statistical analysis

Clinical case CC: one case or more than one is described from the clinical point of view, without statistical analysis.

## HOW TO POST A WORK FOR A 2023 AWARD (until September 30 /2023

Abstracts accepted in the first or second instance may qualify for a prize.

The complete work must be written in Word arial 10 spacing 1.5 to the Scientific Committee before September30, 2023 in electronic format (mail). to the mail <a href="mailto:residenciacmsam@gmail.com">mailto:residenciacmsam@gmail.com</a>

The works will be qualified by a jury of 2 members for each work and according to a scoring grid, the work that exceeds an established minimum qualifies for a prize. If there are other jobs in the same situation, the job with the highest

qualifying score in the corresponding area wins. The coordination of the jury committee can change the option chosen by the authors, respecting the 2nd thematic option chosen by the authors, when there are many works in certain thematic areas

The best works (among the first 14 to 16 by score) of the Free Communication (CL) type of the areas awarded for their score and that have been presented at the congress, compete for the Grand Prize during the congress in Punta Cana The jury chooses the prizes and the mentions that it considers pertinent.

The clinical cases and case series are graded with an ad-hoc grid at the time they are presented and the work with the highest score in the area is the winner.

All prizes are announced at the closing ceremony.

The following categories FC and CC and special categories are awarded as best work.

Therefore there are 32 awardable thematic areas for each category of work (FL and CC) In addition there are prizes for the best work in each category

The work must contain: Format: written in word 2003/2010 or earlier Font: Arial Size 10 Line spacing 1.5

First page: Cover with title, authors and center where it was carried out, thematic area chosen by the authors and finally accepted by the Scientific Committee by putting the 1st option and optional 2nd option that was chosen when submitting the online abstract

Second sheet with cover only with the title and the subject area.

Subsequently, the items are:

- 1. Summary
- 2. Introduction with objectives at the end of it
- 3. Material and methods
- 4. Results (free text)
- 5. Discussion (with conclusions at the beginning or end of it)
- 6. Recommendations (optional)
- 7. Bibliography according to order of appearance in the text with a New England Journal Medicine style model.
- 8. Annex: Tables, graphs, description of instruments, etc.
